Bibs

Distributed at registration table in the morning. AVSC on Saturday, Spring Gulch on Sunday. Athletes registered for both days will keep their bibs on Saturday to use again on Sunday. There will be a \$60.00 fee for lost or damaged bibs.

Waxing Area

Saturday: Outside in the back of AVSC, limited power will be available

Sunday: Anywhere skiers left of the finish area. There is no power available at Spring Gulch.

We recommend LF and CH glide waxes only; however there is not waxing protocol for this event.

Bathrooms

<u>Saturday</u>- AVSC clubhouse, please make sure you instruct your athletes to keep it clean! Additional porta potties are located in the AVSC parking lot.

Sunday- porta potties only.

Directions to Aspen High School Trails (Saturday):

From the Element Hotel in Basalt, drive East on Hwy 82 towards Aspen. At Aspen traffic circle, take first exit onto Maroon Creek Road, go left on Moore Drive, left on AVSC Drive, pass AVSC on the right and drop off at the high school. **Absolutely no parking at AVSC or Aspen High School!!! Parking**: Aspen Middle School Lot- Go back down Maroon Creek Rd, first right on Bus Barn Lane, walk up ally to AVSC.

Directions to Spring Gulch Trail System (Sunday):

From the Element Hotel in Basalt, head west on Hwy 82 towards Carbondale. Use the left two lanes to turn left on CO-133. At the traffic circle, take the first exit onto Main St. Continue onto Co Rd 106, take a slight left onto Co Rd 108. Dirve about 6 miles and find the Spring Gulch Trail System on your Right. Watch for speed dips and please obey the speed limit on this road. The ranch owners on your way up are the people that make skiing at Spring Gulch possible. **Parking:** Fill the parking lot first, overflow parking will be on the road.
